Members 15 present

- **Grand Knight:** Tom opened the meeting and thanked all who helped with the degree ceremony that was held previous to tonight's meeting at 6:30PM in the Chapel at Blessed Sacrament. New member Mike Finn received his 2nd and 3rd in combination degrees. Tom also read a letter from the Hope Appeal asking for our continuous support of the program. Tom also has some books to assist with the Lenten season, if anyone is interested in reading them.
- **Financial Secretary:** 74 Total members, 49 associates, 21 insurance, 4 inactive, 2 Honoree, 28 Honoree Life, 4 inactive and 1 EXM. Jim reported Annual fraternal Survey and Semi-Annual Audit was completed and sent in. Jim also reported 3 members withdrew and 16 were moved to Supreme.
- **New Business:** Breakfast for the communion class in May. Discussions to help with purchasing Coffee, donuts and pastries instead of cooking a whole meal, churches request. This way they would like to invite the whole parish to join in. Members will vote on in April, possible costs to the Knight about \$300.00. Also time to start thinking about the Bishops Burse.
