- **Grand Knight:** Tom opened the meeting and thanked all who helped at the Pasta dinner. It was a success and approximately \$2,500 was donated to the Eagles fund from the profits we made. Knights donated the food and supplies, about \$474. Grand Knight also read thank you notes from Sisters of St. Joseph's, Holy Cross, and Hope Appeal.
- **Financial Secretary:** 92 Members, 63 associates, 23 insurance, 5 inactive, 2 Honoree, 28 Honoree Life, 4 inactive and 1 EXM. Jim reported \$170.75 bill due. Jim also reported on 16 members that are behind in dues were moved to Affiliate, off our roster and moved to Supreme.
- **New Business:** Membership drive at Blessed Sacrament new member signed up, Lawrence Davis. We are planning on doing a combined, 1,2,3 combined, degree ceremony at 6:30 PM on March 6th, preceding our regular monthly meeting. Also in future, for breakfast with the communion class suggested do coffee, donuts, pastries instead of a full breakfast and invite the whole parish after the communion.
- **Treasurers report:** Ted passed out copies of all checks written and deposits. Ted also announced our taxes have been completed and the Semi-Annual Audit is also completed.
- **Events:** Nothing planned, discussion on doing our next fund raiser as raising funds for the Knights, all profits to replenish some of our funds.
- **Donations:**

 4. Motion was made by Paul for \$300 (only \$1 each, no shipping charge) to Blessed Sacrament Parrish council for books, "Holy Moments" by Mathew Kelly, Dave 2nd the motion, all were in favor, motion passed.
 5. Dan motioned we pay \$20 each to offset the cost, to the first 5 members who sign up for Ignite conference, for March 25th, Fran 2nd the motion, all were in favor, motion passed. Member would show that they signed up and paid and will be reimbursed the \$20.
