November 6th, 2022 Meeting Notes Members 10 present

- **Grand Knight:** Tom opened the meeting and asked for prayers for all those affected by the Wars. Tom received letters from food pantries and officers will review and advise on donations.
- **Financial Secretary**: 71 Total members, 47 associates, 21 insurance, 4 inactive, 2 Honoree, 27 Honoree Life, 4 inactive and 0 EXM. Jim let us know no money is owed at this time. We received the \$100 back for RSVP. Jim also talked about donations for food, like ours to food pantries are eligible for every \$500 we do, we can get back \$100 from Supreme. Jim will do paperwork for 2023. Jim will also be sending the fraternal survey along with the next newsletter.
