- **New Business:** Catholic Schools week there was discussion of having a pasta dinner for Eagles fund. Tom will check with School when it will be held, usually Saturday in Catholic schools' week. There will also be a sign-up sheet for volunteers to help. If you cannot attend until later in the day, 4pm – 7pm is needed for service and clean up.
- **Coats for Kids:** Was a great success. Purchased \$3,710.62 worth of coats, which included a single \$1000.00 donation from parishioner from St. Margarets. 15 cases of coats were purchased. Thank you for all the Knights that helped with purchasing and distribution of the coats.
- **C&B:** 73 books were sold and of today a net profit of \$300 for the council.
- **Treasurers report:** Ted passed out report on all checks written and deposits. Also, that we gave \$100 to BS Church for use of Chappell for Mass for deceased and \$500 to BS for rent for our meeting place for the year. The annual audit will be completed by end of December to be signed by the trustees in January's meeting.
- **Lecturer:** Deacon Dan talked about the first Monday in Advent and Advent in general.
- **Events:** No update, checking on date for pasta dinner.
