March 4th, 2024 Meeting Notes

Members 9 present

- **Grand Knight:** Tom opened the meeting and talked about the Eagles fund and how much give out and how they are raising funds. Read thank you from food pantries, and a letter from Francis House. Tom also received the COR start up guide for men of the parish, not just Knights of Columbus members. Tom also read and article from the NY times about Gaza. Tom also mentioned article on marriage and family life.
- **Fish Fry at Blessed Sacrament:** Dave said thank you for the donation to the fish fry and the placemats we provided. They are also short on help for 3/15 and 3/22 if anyone is available and can help.
- **Financial Secretary:** 71 Total members, 47 associates, 20 insurance, 4 inactive, 3 Honorary, 27 Honorary Life, 4 inactive and 0 EXM. Also, we lost 2 members, Bob Cusano passed and another transferred to another council. No money is owed currently. We received \$146 bonus check from C&B ticket sales. Jim will submit the paperwork for RSVP for families refund and ASAP applications. Jim is also sending in the information for the State Convention. Jim also let is know about a program for The State, for another \$100 from them for our donation to Seminarians. Jim will fill out paperwork for this. Jim also talked about Knights scholarships are for High Schools as well as colleges. Jim also received 2 Kiosk and booklets to put at churches.
